SYNOPSIS:

On 01/23/2023, at approximately 1109 hours, a UPD Police Cadet was dispatched to a report of a bicycle theft from the area of the bicycle rack on the west exterior of the San Jose State University (SJSU) Engineering Building. The incident occurred on 01/22/2023, between approximately 1500 hours to 1700 hours. I contacted the victim, JOSEPH CARRILLO. There is suspect information. SCENE DESCRIPTION:

INVESTIGATION:

On 01/23/2023, at approximately 1109 hours I was dispatched to a report of a bicycle theft from the area of the west exterior of the SJSU Engineering Building. I contacted the victim, JOSEPH CARRILLO, and obtained a statement.

STATEMENT OF JOSEPH CARRILLO:

The following statement is a summary and not verbatim.

On 01/22/2023, at approximately 1500 hours, CARRILLO locked his bicycle with a brass chain lock to the bicycle rack located on the west exterior of the SJSU Engineering Building.

At approximately 1700 hours he returned and found his bicycle and lock missing. He described the bicycle taken as a Beach Cruiser Black Body Electra 1 Speed with chrome wheels, chrome handle bars, and two chrome mirrors all valued at approximately \$589.00. CARRILLO provided the following serial number for his bike (#WTU241A0057RR). Additionally, CARRILLO stated that his brass chain lock was approximately \$250.00.

No one else had permission nor access to use his bicycle. He did wish to press charges if the suspect were found.

INVESTIGATION Continued:

I provided CARRILLO with a case number. There area no cameras in the area of where the bicycle was taken. CARRILLO also provided the serial number of the bike #WTU241A0057RR which has been entered into automated property system(APS).
